INTRODUCTION

Knowledge is the output of the relation between subject who knows and known object. On the other hand, culture is a system of beliefs and customs which is utilized for understanding, organizing and restructuring the communal living of a group of people and individual living through the history and community development process. Furthermore, the Islamic Culture is both earthly and spiritual richness that is bequeathed by Islam to the Muslims. Muslim Culture constitutes a whole with its ilm, iman and amal. In this context knowledge and culture are inseparable parts of each other.

“The Integrity of Knowledge” as the title of this symposium means the scope of knowledge that is needed in interpreting a topic and commenting on this topic. “The Integrity of Knowledge” is a significant factor for drawing holistic conclusions when a scientific research is being conducted.

In the Western World, scientific and knowledge perception have been changed with the Enlightenment Period starting in 17th and 18th centuries. Constructing different fields in each branch of the science by classifying and creating sub-branches is the essential need for idea of development and modernization. This does not have only advantage that providing detailed knowledge in related branch but also disadvantage that oversimplifying everything related with governance, all aspects of communal life and all economic activities by just considering them as politics, sociology and economic theory, respectively. Hence, the holistic view has disappeared.

In recent years, within the scope of the integrity of knowledge, the need for “interdisciplinary studies” has been drawn the attentions more and more. How should the methodology of social sciences be shaped in today’s world is the main discussion of this symposium. Likewise, sciences of religions have some issues stem from lack of the integrity of knowledge. The aforementioned issues can be listed as (1) problems in identification of departments and the need for interdisciplinary studies, (2) acceptable integrity of knowledge in preservation and formation of religious culture, (3) superficial knowledge in the fields except for the area of specialization, (4) encyclopedical depiction of scholars, (5) the integrity of ilm and amal.

Especially, the integrity of knowledge in sciences of religion will be addressed in “International Symposium on the Integrity of Knowledge in Islam Civilization from Past to Future
